

DEER HARVEST REPORTING INSTRUCTIONS & LOG

All hunters, regardless of age or license requirement,* must log (Step 1) their harvested deer prior to moving it from the point where the hunter located the harvested deer and report (Step 2) the harvested deer within 24 hours. These steps can be completed using one of the following options:**

Option 1 – FWC Deer Harvest Reporting App – Hunters can both log and report (Steps 1 and 2) on an app-enabled mobile device using the FWC Deer Harvest Reporting App. Instructions for downloading and using the app can be found at MyFWC.com/HarvestReport.

Option 2 – Paper Deer Harvest Log and Follow-Up Reporting – Hunters can log (Step 1) on a paper Deer Harvest Log (courtesy copy below and also available at [MyFWC.com/Harvest Report](http://MyFWC.com/HarvestReport)) and then report (Step 2) by:

- Calling the toll-free Deer Harvest Reporting Hotline at 844-392-DEER (3337) between 8 a.m. - 8 p.m. ET, or
- Using the FWC Deer Harvest Reporting App (Option 1)

Confirmation Number: This confirmation number is not valid until the harvest record is successfully submitted using the FWC Deer Harvest Reporting App or calling the Deer Harvest Reporting Hotline. If using the app, the successful submission will be saved in the “Sent” folder. If using a paper Deer Harvest Log, the confirmation number must be recorded on the log.

** Hunters exempt from license requirements who do not have an FWC customer ID number (CID) can obtain one by going to GoOutdoorsFlorida.com and clicking on “Create Customer Account” before going hunting.*

*** Hunters must report (Step 2) the harvested deer: 1) within 24 hours of harvest, or 2) prior to final processing of the deer, or 3) prior to the deer or any parts of the deer being transferred to a meat processor or taxidermist, or 4) prior to the deer leaving the state, whichever occurs first.*

Helpful Tip! Keep this paper Deer Harvest Log or mobile device with you to avoid any delays in moving your harvested deer.

Important Notes:

Prior to moving a harvested deer, hunters must log their harvest.

Deer harvested on licensed game farms/hunting preserves or those possessed that were killed by motor vehicles do not have to be reported.
